

2011 CMRC ATV RACE SERIES

CMRC ATV General Rules

- 1) The following safety requirements are mandatory for all ATVs:
 - a) Tether cord that functions properly
 - b) Nerf bars or OEM foot boards
 - c) All UTV classes must have extremity restraints
 - d) All classes are subject to random tech inspections throughout race day
- 2) In all classes, the ATV's engine must not exceed class displacement limitations.
- 3) In all ATV production classes, the engine must be from the approved model. The manufacturer's frame, crankcase, cylinder and cylinder head from the approved model must be used as catalogued and sold by the manufacturer of the ATV in question. (*Excludes ATV Novice, Junior, Open Sport, Vet, Mini Open, and Super Mini, Adult Pit Quad)
- 4) All other CMRC rules apply (see 2011 Amateur CMRC rule book for details, however the ATV rules in this book do not apply to CMRC ATV)
- 5) At all CMRC ATV sanctioned events, the rulings of the Referees / Promoters are final.

CMRC ATV Production Classes

Tykes, Beginner, Pee Wee, Thumper, Mini Ladies, Sportsman, Ladies, Ladies Pro, Open Automatic, Intermediate, Pro, and both UTV classes, must stay within displacement limits of the class. Production classes must use the approved OEM cylinder head, cylinder and cases, as well as OEM Frame. Engines cannot be stroked or bored in any production division.

ATV Novice, Junior, Open Sport, Vet, Mini Open, and Super Mini and Adult Pit Quad are not limited to production rules however they must fall within the displacement limits of the class.

CMRC ATV Advancement & Scoring

ATV participants are permitted to compete in more than one class provided they meet the rules and eligibility requirements for that class.

ATV Junior to ATV Intermediate, 18 points; ATV Intermediate to ATV Pro, 24 points; Ladies ATV to Ladies PRO ATV, 24 points.

In instances where a rider's machine becomes disabled prior to reaching the finish line AND he/she completed at least 50 percent of the total number of laps completed by the winner, he/she will receive last place points. In these circumstances, riders will NOT be required to physically push his/her machine across the finish line. Riders who do not physically push their machines across the finish line will be considered as having completed the race.

In the event that a racer has a mechanical failure in the first moto and chooses to race an alternate ATV in the second moto, the racer will start in the back row for the second moto.

CMRC ATV Age Limited Classes

Mini ATV Beginner “ Entry Level” 0-90cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke, only air-cooled engines
- CVT transmissions and semi-automatic transmissions only
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black numbers on white backgrounds
- Maximum 2 years racing in this class (at referees/promoters discretion)
- Maximum 10 years of age as of Jan. 1
- This class is for young first time racers. If you are not sure if this class is for you please call the office.

Mini ATV Tyke PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 50cc 2 stroke or 90cc 4 stroke, Liquid or air-cooled engines
- CVT transmissions and semi-automatic transmissions only
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black numbers on white backgrounds
- Maximum 8 years of age as of Jan. 1

Mini ATV Thumper 0-150cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 4 stroke, only air-cooled engines
- CVT transmissions and semi- automatic transmissions only
- Stock A-arms
- No increase over stock displacement
- Maximum 12 years of age as of Jan. 1

Mini ATV Ladies 0-150cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- CVT transmissions and semi-automatic transmissions only
- Stock A-arms
- No increase over stock displacement
- Maximum 12 years of age as of Jan. 1

CMRC ATV Age Limited Classes (continued)

Mini ATV Pee- Wee 0-90cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- CVT transmissions and semi automatic transmissions only
- Stock A-arms
- No increase over stock displacement
- Red numbers on white backgrounds
- Maximum 12 years of age as of Jan. 1

Mini ATV Open 0-110cc 2-Stroke, 0-150cc 4-Stroke

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- CVT transmissions and semi automatic transmissions only
- Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Black numbers on white backgrounds
- Maximum 14 year old as of Jan. 1

Super Mini ATV (Shifter) 0-110cc 2-Stroke, 0-150cc 4-Stroke

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Manual, semi automatic, or CVT transmissions
- Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Red numbers on white backgrounds
- Maximum 14 year old as of Jan. 1

ATV Sportsman 0-200cc 2-Stroke (Air cooled), 0-250CC 4-Stroke PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black Numbers on white backgrounds
- No mini ATV's
- Maximum 16 years of age as of Jan. 1

ATV Novice 0-400CC

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Red numbers on white backgrounds
- No mini ATV's
- Maximum 17 years of age as of Jan. 1

CMRC ATV Classes 14 Years and Up

Ladies ATV 14 years and older 0-450cc - Under 14 years max. 400cc, PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/ bore / stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black numbers on white backgrounds

ATV PRO Ladies Minimum 14 years 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder/ bore / stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- White numbers on blue backgrounds

ATV Junior Minimum 14 years 0-700cc - A Class & B Class

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Red numbers on white backgrounds
- A class is advanced
- B class is beginner

ATV Open Sport 14 years and older 0-700cc - Under 14 years max. 400cc,

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Under 14 years max. 400cc
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- This class may be a mix of Novice, Junior, Ladies, and Veterans

ATV Intermediate Minimum 14 years 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits.
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Black numbers on yellow backgrounds

CMRC ATV Classes 14 Years and Up (continued)

ATV PRO/AM Minimum 14 years of age 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- This class may be a mix of Intermediates, Veterans & Pro's

ATV Pro Minimum 16 years of age 0-450cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- White numbers on blue backgrounds

ATV Veterans+30 Minimum 30 - 39 years 0-1000cc

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Black numbers on white backgrounds

ATV Vet Master Minimum 40 years 0-1000cc

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Bore, Stroke, Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Red numbers on white backgrounds

ATV Open Automatic 2WD & 4WD Minimum 14 years 0-1000cc PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any 2 or 4WD sport or utility ATV
- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- No increase over stock displacement
- Stock transmission, no auto conversions
- 2WD - Black numbers on white backgrounds
- 4WD - Red numbers on white backgrounds

CMRC UTV, Mechanics & Adult Pit Quad Classes-15 Years and Up

UTV Side X Side Up to 600cc Minimum 16 years of age PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled UTV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Black numbers on white backgrounds

UTV Side X Side Up to 1000cc Minimum 16 years of age PRODUCTION CLASS

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled UTV using OEM cylinder /bore/stroke within displacement limits
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Red numbers on white backgrounds

ATV Mechanics Minimum 18 years 0-1000cc*

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Must not be registered in any other class
- Must purchase a CMRC mechanic's license to enter race
- 1 Moto 3 laps
- No scoring
- \$30 entry fee

Adult Pit Quad Minimum 14 years of age *

- Any production/modified production 4 wheeled mini ATV
- 2 stroke or 4 stroke engines
- Manual, semi automatic, or CVT transmissions
- Non-OEM engines/frames are permitted
- Bore and stroke may be altered but must remain within class displacement limits
- Minimum 14 year old as of Jan. 1
- Must purchase a CMRC license to enter race
- 1 moto for 10 minutes
- No scoring
- \$30 entry fee

2011 CMRC ATV PROVINCIAL RACE SERIES

"TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP"

A team consists of 4 different riders participating in 4 different classes. Round by round, each rider's results will be tabulated and accumulated. At the end of the series, all 4 riders' scores will be added together to determine a team champion.

We encourage teams to have a presence at the races. Uniform ATVs, apparel, tents etc., will attract more sponsors to the team members and the series. Pit together and have a professional display.

A team must register before June 10, 2011. A team entry form is provided and can be e-mailed to darlene@cmrcatv.com. **No mid season rider substitutions will be allowed.** The success of an individual rider in a single defined class will be tracked.

All race results will be tabulated for overall points through to the last race on the schedule.

No cost to sign up just rewards.

A team trophy, individual trophies and awards will go to the winning team members.

CMRC ATV Classes Race Entry Fees

Classes 14 and up: \$45 First class, \$35 Second class, \$25 Third class

Age limited classes: \$45 First class, \$25 Second class, \$20 Third class

CMRC ATV Gate Fees

\$12.00 per adult per event. (Each race day is considered 'one' event)

Support Vehicles (Golf Carts and UTVs):

- Operators must be 14 years or older.
- Operators must purchase a CMRC race or CMRC mechanics licence.
- Operators must sign liability waver form daily.
- Operators must purchase weekend pass for vehicle and attach it to the vehicle or will be subject to ejection from the event.
- Support vehicles must have racers number clearly displayed on the vehicle.
- You are responsible for any and all infractions of the rules by your vehicle, even if you are not in control of the vehicle.
- **Any infraction by the vehicle will result in the associated rider's disqualification from the event.**
